

## Hail and Fairwell to Houston Jackson

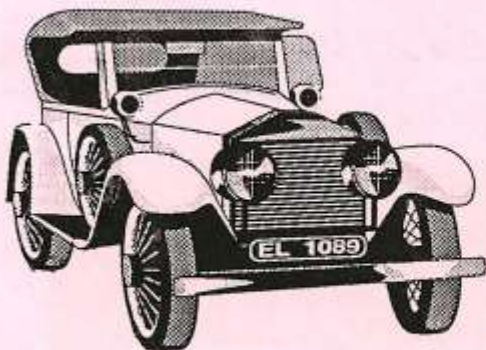
